Bastar Vishwavidyalaya at Jagdalpur (Chhattisgarh) was established in October, 2008 by the Government of Chhattisgarh Under the Chhattisgarh Vishwa Vidyalaya Adhiniyam 1973 with a view to carry out the responsibility of creation, preservation and spreading of knowledge and to provide facility to the students' particularly rural and tribal youth of Bastar in the field of Higher Education. The Vishwavidyalaya aims to hone the skill of our talented youths by imparting value based education and imbibing a culture of specialized course content besides developing their linguistic proficiency and technical know-how to fit them into the framework of global competition. The Vishwavidyalaya has at present 34 affiliated colleges under its jurisdiction out of which 28 are Government colleges and 6 are private colleges. The Vishwavidyalaya in Its University Teaching Department also offers professional and traditional post-graduate degree courses viz., Forestry & Wildlife, Anthropology and Tribal Studies, Rural Technology, Biotechnology, Computer Application and Social Work. The university was established to fulfill the aspiration of tribals to provide them quality higher education and to uplift their life. It has also been observed that there have been drop outs in large numbers amongst tribal students due to different reasons. The idea behind this development plan is to make them available higher education at their door-steps so that GER could enhance in due course of time.

The university is, therefore, striving hard to provide Professional, Vocational and Job-oriented Courses, besides other common and traditional courses to facilitate the students.
